



CAKE AND PIZZA - Review game



Set contains

6 cakes

6 slices of pizza

To make

Cut out the pizza slices and cakes and laminate or cover them with clear plastic.

Make 2 round “plates” out of coloured card, big enough to hold the pizza on one and cakes on the other. Cover these also. [You could also use shop-bought paper plates, but still laminate them]

To prepare

Mount the “plates” onto a background with Blu-tac or velcro.

Mount the pizza onto one plate and the cakes onto the other.

To play

The team which answers the first Bible question chooses to “eat” the pizza or the cakes! Each time a question is answered correctly a piece is removed from their plate.

The first team to clear their plate is the winner.

****NOTE:** Although this is a very simple quiz it is ideal when time is short, e.g. when doing class to class visits in a school. It is attractive, and appeals to kids of all ages.
