



Hens and Chickens

A Review game

Set contains

- 2 hens
- 2 nests
- 12 eggs
- 12 chicks

To make

1. Cut out and laminate the pieces of cover them with sticky-backed plastic . This will give them durability and they will last for years.
2. Cut along the dotted line on the nests after covering.

To prepare

1. Mount the nests onto a background, using Blue-tac, velcro or some other removable adhesive
2. Mount the hens, one beside each nest.
3. Put 6 eggs in each nest, nestle them into the slit you have made. Leave plenty of each egg showing.
Note: Do not mount the chicks at this stage.

To play

1. Ask your lesson review questions.
2. As each correct answer is given, remove an egg from that team's nest and place a chick on the board near their hen.
3. Mix up the direction the chicks are facing. As well as putting the "hatched" chicks in front of the nest, you can also place some in the nest, or on the hen's back!
4. The winner is the first team to "hatch" 6 eggs.

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
